



A quick guide to behaviour management

Our Behaviour Policy aims to recognise each child's individual needs and to foster respect for self, others, environment in a positive way.

Techniques which we employ to facilitate appropriate behaviours in children include:

- Positive interactions/redirection;
- Setting clear, enforceable limits;
- Structuring environment and schedules to maximise appropriate behaviour;
- Recognising and rewarding children's efforts;
- Modelling appropriate behaviours to children;
- Anticipating and eliminating potential problem;
- Use of natural and logical consequences;
- Time out to control and compose self.

We do not use any form of corporal punishment upon your child.

If you are concerned about your child's behaviour please approach us and vice-versa.

The Centre has many resources to assist parents and staff to deal with difficult or age appropriate behaviours.
